



Community Bursary Case Study

Aberdeen Care and Repair

Organisation: Aberdeen Care and Repair

Aim: Aberdeen Care & Repair is part of Castlehill Housing Association. The charity provides free residential advice and technical assistance to older people and those with disabilities, throughout Aberdeen. They offer services in carrying out repairs, home adaptations and improvements such as heating and safety, and security. They also operate an in-house handyman service.

Bursary amount: £2,000

Spend: The purpose of the bursary was to continue to provide the services free of charge.

With the bursary, the charity has been able to provide a number of residents with free advice, products and fitting.

This includes over 100 free visits, the installation of Key Safes, which are essential for those with carers to access their homes and installing security equipment.
